- 2.1** Go for Gold S2 Rallysprint counts towards 2024 Townsville City Autosports Club Rally Championship:

Article 3 Event Description

- 3.1** The **Go for Gold S2 Rallysprint** authorised by Motorsport Australia permit No **424/1905/06**. The event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) Of Motorsport the 2024 Rallysprint Standing Regulations, These Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and Bulletins as may be authorised by Motorsport Australia The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.
- 3.2** Competition Day 1 will begin at 11:00 hrs at Millchester Motorsport Complex 18th May 2024
Competition Day 1 will finishes at 16:00hrs at Milchester Motorsport Complex 18th May 2024
Competition Day 2 will begin at 08:00 hrs at Millchester Motorsport Complex 19th May 2024
Competition Day 2 will finishes at 13:00hrs at Milchester Motorsport Complex 19th May 2024
The approximate distances will be: **TBA** Klm's Competitive

Article 4 Vehicle Eligibility

- 4.1** The classes to be used for this Event are as per the 2024 Motorsport Australia Manual

Class P2 PRC Over 1401cc, up to and including 1600cc

Class P3 PRC Over 1601cc, up to and including 2000cc

Class P4 PRC 2WD over 2001cc

Class P5 PRC Four-wheel drive, over 2000cc (not meeting the requirements of Class P6). Mitsubishi models Evolution 7 onwards and Subaru GDA onwards. Any 4WD vehicle with a fully active differential* irrespective of their model or year.

Class P6 PRC Mitsubishi models up to and including Evolution 6.5 and Subaru models up to and including GC8. For other four-wheel drive vehicles, models must be first manufactured prior to 1 January, 1998. P6 precludes the use of fully active differentials*.

Club Rally Cars

Article 5 Entry Forms, Entries and Entry Fees

- 5.1** The entry fee for Go for Gold Rallysprint is \$270.00
- 5.2** Entries will open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations close Wednesday at 16:00 hrs 15th May 2024. An entry may be substituted for one lodged prior to the closing date of entries in respect of which the competitor has advised his inability to compete. Entries must be made on the official form which must be fully completed and signed as per the NCR and emailed to the event secretary.

- 5.3** Entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organisers subject to the NCR.
A limit of 30 starters may be applied and the organiser reserves the right to cancel the event if less than 30 entries are received. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt, the latest being excluded first.
If a number of entries are received on the same day causing the limit to be exceeded, a ballot will be held.
- 5.4** Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.
- 5.5** The entry fee will be refunded in full:
- * to candidates whose entry has not been accepted
 - * in case of the rally not taking place
 - * withdrawal of entry prior to close of entries

In case of withdrawal, after close of entries, due to reasons of force majeure recognised by the stewards of the meeting, the organisers may refund part of the entry fee.

5.6 The crew shall consist of a driver and co-driver who must retain their respective roles throughout the Event.

5.7 Financial members of Motorsport Australia affiliated clubs are eligible to participate in the event

5.8 A Motorsport Australia Rally/Rally Junior Licence or higher.

Article 6 Servicing

6.1 Service crews must be registered with the Organisers and will be provided with Service Instructions. The registration of one service crew is included in the entry fee.

6.2 The maximum distance between service/refuel points will be approximately 1 km.

6.3 The passage of service vehicles and servicing by persons other than the crew of the competing vehicle is banned on roads as specified. Any infringement of this regulation noted by an Official of the Event may result in a charge being laid by the Clerk of the Course.

6.4 There is fuel available at Charters Towers. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

6.5 Smoking(which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 meters of any refueling/defueling operation.

6.6 Central service point is at the Rally service park Millchester Motorsport Complex.

Article 7 Competitors Briefing

7.1 A competitor’s briefing will be held at Rally HQ 09:00 Hrs Saturday 18th May 2024.

A competitor’s briefing will be held at Rally HQ 7:50 hrs Sunday 19th May 2024.

It is compulsory for both crew members of each car to attend. Failure to sign-on at the Briefing to indicate your attendance **will be referred** to the Stewards.

Article 8 Reconnaissance and Pace Noting

8.1 The passage of any crew member on any of the stages of the Event is banned from the time of publication of these Regulations to the beginning of the Rallysprint. Any infringement of this Regulations noted by an Official of the Event may result in a Penalty being imposed by the Stewards.

Article 9 Promotion

9.1 Through entering this Event all Competitors and crew members agree to the free use of their name and photographs in any promotional material prepared and issued by the Organisers.

9.2 All advertising, sales promotion and publicity material concerning or referring to the Event should refer prominently to the Event as the **Go for Gold Rallysprint**.

9.3 All competitors and crew members are requested to provide publicity material concerning themselves and sponsor on the form provided when lodging their entry.

Article 11 Odometer Check

11.1 The official vehicle for the Event has recorded a reading of 5.00 km over the Queensland

Transport Speedo Check of 5km. (south of the Australian Institute of Marine Science turn off approx 27 km south of Townsville). A duplicate check will be set up Makeking Road

Article 12 Documentation and Scrutiny

- 12.1** Documents establishing civil registration and Third Party Insurance cover as well as appropriate Motorsport Australia vehicle registration and Vehicle with a Motorsport Australia Log Book must be produced at pre-event scrutiny. Log Books will be collected at time of Scrutiny and held by Event Officials until completion of Post-event Scrutiny. For Queensland registered vehicles a certificate of Third Party Extension for this Event is required specifying cover for Go for Gold Rallysprint 18th & 19 May 2024.
- 12.2** Relevant Motorsport Australia Competitor and competitor licences as well as a current civil licence for the driver must be presented to the Organisers prior to the start, preferably at pre-event scrutiny.
- 12.3** A change of crew members or vehicle may be considered by the Clerk of the Course before close of scrutiny and may be approved subject to the agreement of the Stewards of the Event.
- 12.4** Competitor numbers will be supplied by the Organisers, advertising and competition numbers.
- 12.4** Competitors are required to leave an area of at least 500mm and 140mm high on the bonnet and boot for the event sponsors rally decals. Competitors are reminded of the requirements of Schedule K Motorsport Sustralia Manual.
- 12.7** The requirement for fire extinguishers is in Schedule H of Motorsport Australia Manual.
- 12.8** The Chief Scrutineer will conduct checks on competitive vehicles throughout the Event
- 12.9** A vehicle deemed unsafe by the Clerk of the Course, Deputy Clerk of the Course or Chief Scrutineer or his deputy during the running of event will not be allowed to continue.
- 12.10** Selected vehicles may be required for post-event scrutiny and be subject to sealing of components. Post event scrutiny will be conducted at Rally HQ after the last vehicle has finished if required .
- 12.11** The starting order will be determined by seeding.
- 12.12** Vehicles shall comply with Schedule A and Article 8 of the 2024 Rallysprint Standing Regulations.
- 12.13** Noise Testing - All vehicles will be required to conform to Atricle 8.2b 2024 Motorsport Australia Rallsprint Regulations and may be tested in accordance with these methods.
- 12.14** Vehicle logbooks may be held by the Chief Scrutineer until the end of the Event.

Article 13 Running Details

- 13.1** Go for Gold S2 Rallysprint will start at Rally HQ at 11:00 hrs Saturday 18th May 2024. and finish at approximately 16:00hrs 18th May 2024.
Sunday 19th May 2024 at 08:00 hrs and finish at 13:00 hrs
Penalties of one minute per minute may apply to crews booking in late.
- 13.2** Minimum time intervals between cars at start controls will be two minutes. This interval may be increased at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
- 13.3** The first car should finish the event at approximately Day 1 Saturday 18th May 2024 16:00 hrs
Day 2 Sunday 19th May 2024 13:00 hrs 2024.
The finish location for event shall be at Rally HQ Millchester Motorsport Complex

- 13.4** Performance Record, Scoring and Results will be in accordance with the Rally Standing Regulations – Event General.
Any lateness exceeding 30 minutes of the target time between two time controls or a total lateness exceeding 40 minutes at the end of the first section, or a total lateness of more than 60 minutes, will result in the exclusion of the crew.
- 13.6** Provisional classification will be posted by 13:15hrs Sunday 19th My 2024.
- 13.7** Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
- 13.8** The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- 13.9** All competitors are requested to advise a Control Official at the Time Control or Stop Point of the stage in which they retire, of their retirement from the event by lodging with the official a form to be supplied by the Organisers for that purpose.
- 13.10** With regard to the obstruction of vehicles, competitors are reminded of the provisions of the National Rallsprint Code concerning overtaking, obstruction and the use of reflective safety triangles.

13.12 Integrity

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.
Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.
Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, an Australia y drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

Exclusion of Liability, Release and Indemnity

- nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded, however the liability of Motorsport Australia and the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
- nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a Motorsport Australia insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
- Motorsport Australia has arranged for limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motorsport Activities. I acknowledge and accept that the insurance taken out by Motorsport Australia may not provide me with full indemnity for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motorsport Activities, and that I may have to pay the excess if a Claim is made under an insurance policy on my behalf. I agree that my own insurance arrangements are ultimately my responsibility and I will arrange any additional coverage at my expense after taking into account Motorsport Australia's insurance arrangements, this document and my own circumstances.

- any product resulting from those services, will be of such a nature, and quality, state or condition, that they might reasonably be expected to achieve the result that the consumer wishes to achieve, (as long as that wish is made known to the supplier or a person with whom negotiations have been conducted in relation to the acquisition of the services).

Excluding, Restricting or Modifying My Rights:

Under section 42 of the **Fair Trading Act 1987 (SA)**, the supplier of recreational services is entitled to ask me to agree to exclude, restrict or modify their liability for any personal injury suffered by me or another person for whom, or on whose behalf, I am acquiring the services (a third party consumer). - "Motorsport Activities" means any motorsport activities or Recreational Services which are permitted or approved which Motorsport Australia regulates or administers or otherwise are under the responsibility / control of Motorsport Australia;
- "Motorsport Australia" means the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. trading as Motorsport Australia;
- "Reckless Conduct" means conduct where the supplier of the recreational services is aware, or should reasonably have been aware, of a significant risk that the conduct could result in personal injury to another person and engages in the conduct despite the risk and without adequate justification;
- "Recreational Services" means (unless otherwise defined in this document) services that consist of participation in:
 - a sporting activity; or
 - a similar leisure time pursuit or any other activity that:
 - involves a significant degree of physical exertion or physical risk; and
 - is undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure.
