- Cars must be adequately muffled.

The manner in which the results will be determined and prizes awarded	Results will be provided at the end of the event. Trophies will be presented for the Club Khanacross Series at the TCAC end of year awards presentation. NQ Invitational will be divided into 4 classes being 1- 2WD to 2000cc 2- 2WD 2001cc over 3- AWD to 2500cc 4- AWD 2501cc over multiplier will be used to determine engine size for turbo engines. (engine cc x 1.7=) example 2ltr engine (1998cc x 1.7 = 3396cc)
OTHER EVENT REQUIREMENTS	TCAC plans to run a Top 3 shootout in each class if time allows. Concept: A fresh Khanacross track will be set up. The top three competitors from each NQ Invitational class will each complete the track once, and the best combined time will be crowned the Class Shootout Champion.
Integrity	Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3

Passengers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passengers will be allowed in vehicles at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. • Passenger waivers must be signed prior to participating in the event. • Passengers must attend the compulsory driver briefing, unless organised with the Clerk of the Course. • Apparel is as per the minimum requirements for competitors in accordance with these regulations <p>This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.</p>
Timing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Timekeepers will be appointed at the discretion and decision of the Clerk of the Course. • Handheld stopwatches will be used. • Timing shall start at the competitors own time when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated start line and cease when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated finish line. <p>A low-speed convoy run may be held before the start of competition on each course in accordance with the current Khanacross Standing Regulations.</p>
Penalties	<p>Penalties shall be awarded in accordance with the Khanacross Standing Regulations</p>
Point scoring	<p>Competitors shall be ranked by outright time.</p>
Judges of Fact	<p>All officials and timekeepers at test areas shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with the NCR of the Motorsport Australia Manual and Khanacross Standing Regulations</p>
General	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Camping, toilet and shower facilities are available on site. • A speed limit of 10 km/h must apply in the pit area and when proceeding between tests. • Cars may park only in the designated areas between tests unless agreed upon by the Clerk of the Course or Chief Scrutineer to undertake repairs • Food & Drinks Saturday Lunch & Dinner, Sunday Breakfast & Lunch Competitors Fee includes the 4 meals.
